<sup>1</sup>But now thus says the LORD, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine. <sup>2</sup>When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you. <sup>3</sup>For I am the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior. Isaiah 43:1-3

Here God doesn't promise the people of Israel that there will never be times of fire, of flood, of feeling overwhelmed. If Isaiah were speaking in the 1960's, he might have said, "God doesn't promise you a rose garden". God doesn't promise that there will not be periods in life when we feel overwhelmed and at the mercy of things beyond our own control.

What God does promise the people of Israel is that they will not be alone in these troubles and disasters. God promises to be with them.

God promises the same things to us as well. At times, it may seem that we are drowning in a fast-moving river or trapped in the middle of a wildfire, but God promises to be with us as well.

Why? Simply because God created us and loves us. Later in this passage, God calls us "precious" and reminds us that we are beloved.

This passage from Isaiah is a part of God's Valentine card to us. It's a long card, actually more of a story, but the message is this: God loves us. God has always loved us. God will always love us.

The greatest proof of that love is seen in Jesus.

This Valentine's Day and always, may our response to this love be a great big heartfelt sigh of relief. And then, may we respond by caring for and loving ourselves and our neighbors and our enemies.

### SOUPER BOWL



### **CELEBRATION OF MARRIAGE**






