Prayer

Prayer Notes

Room? It is located behind the altar, its entrance on the pulpit side. It's not a large space, perhaps 8' x 12'. Currently it has seating for eleven and a kneeler. Over the years this room has provided space for prayer partners, Bible studies, individual prayer, private conversation/sharing. It's a welcoming spot for renewal and an escape from our busy world . . . who wouldn't welcome that?

The window of the Prayer Room is embellished with Luther's Rose, a widely recog-



nized symbol of Lutheranism designed by Martin Luther in 1516 setting forth the basic beliefs of Christians . . . the black cross is our salvation from sin because Jesus died on the cross, the red heart is Jesus' blood shed for us, and the white flower is the peace and joy we gain from our faith.

The Prayer Room is also furnished with Bibles, hymnals, devotionals, prayer books and a CD/ cassette player if you wish to have some music. I had forgotten that the kneeler was in the room and it brought forth a word origin I had just learned. The word "bless" is influenced by the Hebrew word **brk** which means "to bend" which can imply kneeling. The writer of this information pictured Jesus bending down when she prays to hear her words, and has always felt something

powerful about praying while kneeling. Having been raised Catholic I did a lot of kneeling not only for prayer, but during the celebration of Mass. You may want to give it a try when in the Prayer Room . . . kneeling = strengthened faith = blessing!

Experience the **Prayer Room** when you have some time. Experience it alone or take someone with you. God wants to hear from us and He has a few things to share with us too. Embrace the quiet of the room, relax and let God direct your ways. God's power lives within each of us and is ours to use. Give yourself the time to draw upon this gift in a small moment in a new place.


